The empirical research proposals on other topics, requiring the use of tools of economic analysis and/or computer science techniques, are also welcome. The working language is **English**.

Deadline for applications is March 29, 2020.

- to attend the lectures of distinguished experts in various spheres of empirical economics and finance, as well as in big data proceeding and analysis;
- to present and discuss your current research during seminars;
- to exchange the research experience with other RSSIA participants and faculty members;

Application

Participants are selected on the basis of their applications. You should apply online:

- fill in a registration form;
- write a motivation letter (no longer than **300** words);
- provide a current research project description (no longer than **1500** words + references) with a short abstract (no longer than **200** words).

There is no registration fee. Organizers cover participants' accommodation and food costs. However, participants will have to cover their travel and visa costs.
